Reflection & Discussion Questions Believing in God's Guidance Isaiah 58:11

1. The Lord promises to guide us *continually*. We do not get the complete roadmap of our life all at once. What does this mean in terms of your attentiveness to His leading? Are you taking time each day to discern His direction?

2. How has the Lord led you in the past? Have there been times when you missed His leading? How did He steer you back onto the correct path?

3. What do you do during those times when you are uncertain about what course of action to follow, and God seems to be silent?

4. Are there areas of your life where God offers no guidance? (For example, what to have for breakfast, what to wear today, what task to complete first, etc.) How do you decide which matters in your day are worthy of prayerful discernment, and which ones to simply undertake on your own?

5. What is it like for your soul to be in a drought? How does the Lord satisfy your soul when you find yourself in that place?

6. Since a garden does not do well without water, how can you be sure that you will receive a continual supply from the Lord?

7. A spring of water requires a constant flow of fresh water to prevent it from becoming stagnant. What will be your source of Living Water that will not fail to refresh your stream? How can this spring be redirected to become a blessing to others?

8. Have you grieved the Holy Spirit by taking over His job of guiding your life? If so, would this not be the time to humble yourself, repent, and ask Him to take control once again so that you may be refreshed and a source of refreshment to others?
